Enter weather and ski conditions in log.		Cleared to leave by management.	
Base Station Radio is on and volume is audible. Radio is on First Aid Room desk.		All radios are in charging rack and lights are on.	
Inventory Sled Bag, replace any missing items or note unavailability of them.		Remove all patrol equipment from sled and close shelter. Stow equipment in First Aid Room.	
Put Cervical Collar and Cascade or Quick Splint with the Sled Bag.		Note missing or used items.	
Ensure straps are with backboard. Stow board near Sled Bag.		Ensure all Patrollers are signed out.	
Unzip and roll up front door of shelter; then secure door so it remains open.		Make sure First Aid Room heat and lights are turned off.	
Free up sled from any ice or snow. Ensure Cascade toboggan is in the shelter.			
Check oxygen level in bottle. Replace if below 600 psi and mark empty bottle as EMPTY.			
Ensure radio charging station is on: lights are either green or red.
